Our program is guided by the five principles and practices of the Early Years Learning Framework.



The program links to the WA Education Curriculum and provides children with the required skills and knowledge that lay the foundation for success in formal schooling.



What will your child experience at our school readiness program?

- They will be lead by an Early Childhood Teacher who sets the day's activities.
- They will be introduced to subjects such as literacy, numeracy, maths, science and health.
- There will be a focus on group projects and activities, where they will learn extensive social skills and how to work collaboratively together.
- A supportive learning environment, where they will learn to be resilient and try new things.
- We provide experiences that will develop their self help skills, promote independence and responsibility.
- It will be a structured day from 9.00am -3.00pm.



We provide an environment specifically designed to introduce 3-4 years olds to intentional teaching while supporting our play based approach. We look at each child to support them to be successful learners in all areas of their development.

You will receive updates in real time from our team through our app Xplor. Our Early Childhood Teacher also provides transition reports for entry into Kindergarten.
