

MERCY MEDICAL CENTRE

The Mercy Medical Centre supports the Hospital with medical consulting rooms, a retail pharmacy and GP After Hours clinic. With free and easy visitor parking at the rear of the building, just off Ellesmere Road, the centre provides its visitors with both convenience and accessibility.

MERCY CONFERENCE CENTRE

Located on the first floor of the Ursula Frayne Unit the Centre can cater for a maximum group of 120 people. Smaller areas which can accommodate 10-45 people are also available through the hire of Seminar Room 1 or 2 within the centre. With sweeping views of the Swan River and Perth CBD, the Mercy Conference Centre is suitable for business, cocktail and educational functions.

The facility is not available for non-hospital related functions during weekday office hours and is a non-smoking venue. THE FLORIST AT MERCY

Located in the main reception foyer The Florist at Mercy provides floral arrangements, confectionery, newsagency items, telephone cards and a range of gift items. For patients' convenience a shop trolley visits the wards daily.

The Mercy Café is located on the ground floor of the Hospital and is available for patients, visitors and staff.

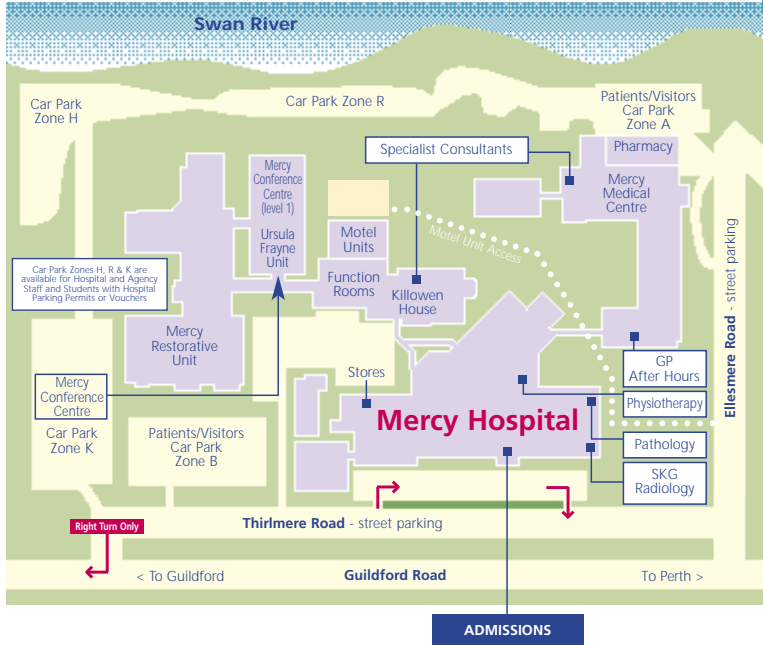
LOCATION AND PARKING

Hospital visiting hours 8.00am - 1.00pm and 3.00pm - 8.00pm.

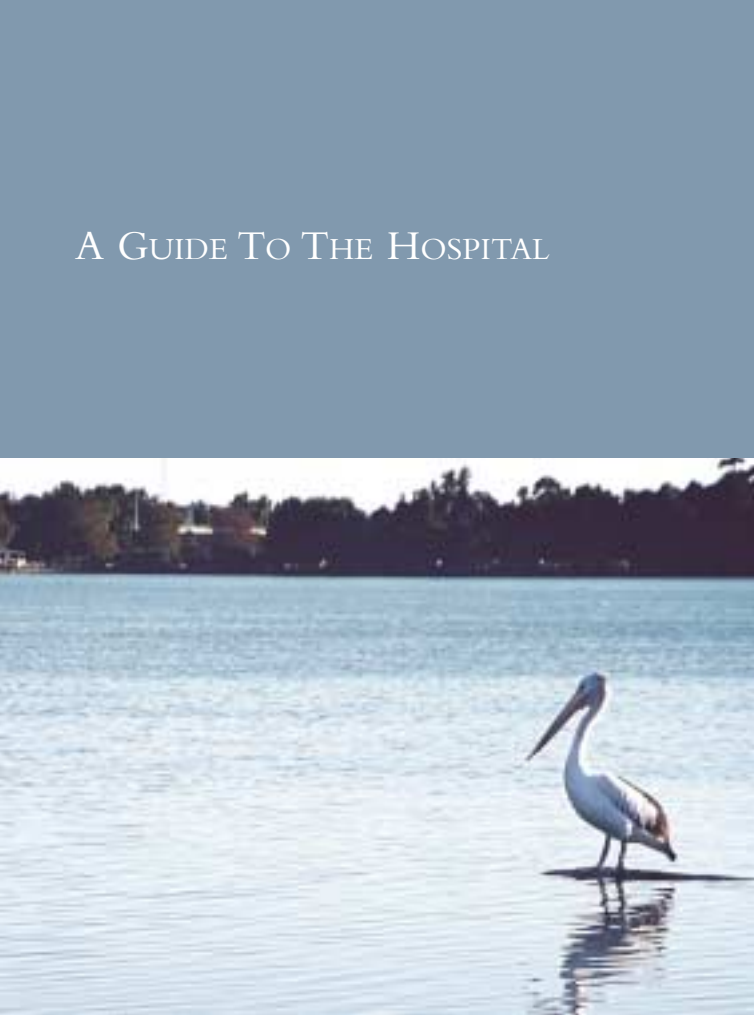
The Hospital's main entrance is closed from 9.00pm - 6.30am.

OUR HERITAGE

As a Catholic Hospital and a member of the Mercy Group the Hospital is committed to upholding the Mission and Values in the care and support of its patients, families, employees, doctors and community.

Mercy Hospital Mount Lawley was founded in 1937 by the Sisters of Mercy who hold a high profile throughout the world as healthcare providers, renowned for their compassion, respect, integrity and lifelong commitment to delivering spiritually based health care services.

Catherine McAuley, a young woman of means, formed a group of religious women, the Sisters of Mercy, in Ireland in 1827 to care for people in need.

The first Australian congregation of Sisters arrived in Western Australia in 1846. We owe the establishment of Mercy Hospital Mount Lawley to the dedication and foresight of one of these early Sisters, Mother Brigid McDonald.

For more than seventy years the Sisters and staff have faithfully followed the traditions of their founders, through their caring and understanding, bringing compassion to life for everyone they encountered.

Today Mercy Hospital Mount Lawley continues working to identify and respond to the needs of the community in the spirit of its founders.
